COVID 19 ON-SET GUIDELINES\*



- Crew, cast, and personnel on location must limited to the fewest number of people needed. (Up to 12 maximum people in a single location in SF & up to 20 people in other counties).
- A designated person will take people's temperature upon arriving on set. If you have a temperature of 100.4 or more, you will be asked to leave. And everyone must answer the COVID screening questions.
- Everyone MUST comply with social distancing, face covering, and sanitation requirements.
- A designated area will be set up that will have disinfecting products for keeping high touch areas on set sanitized.
- Each department should strive to be self-contained. Lighting and grip department should only handle lighting and grip equipment, camera department should only handle camera gear.
  IF crew will be sharing equipment, that equipment must be wiped down between uses and gloves are recommended.
- Props must be cleaned and disinfected before and after each use and hands should be cleaned after handling props and accessories.
- Whenever possible, release forms, scripts, and production book should be sent out electronically.
- Make-up, wardrobe, and hair. Gloves must be worn when working with talent. Talent may remove their facemask when having make-up applied and it strongly recommended that talent arrive with hair and make-up done. This will reduce the amount of time for personal contact with the make-up artist and stylists. Make-up artists must be Barbicide COVID certified and wear all necessary PPE gear.
- Crew must wear gloves when "touching" talent. (Make-up or mic'ing up).
- When filming only essential talent, crew and personnel should be present.
- When not on-set, please keep at least 6 feet apart and do not gather in groups.
- Food and beverages should be individually packaged. No "buffet style" food service is allowed. Including salad bars, trays of food, or any food service that requires sharing of utensils (serving spoons or tongs).
- Cast and crew should NOT leave the job site to obtain food or drink during the shoot.
